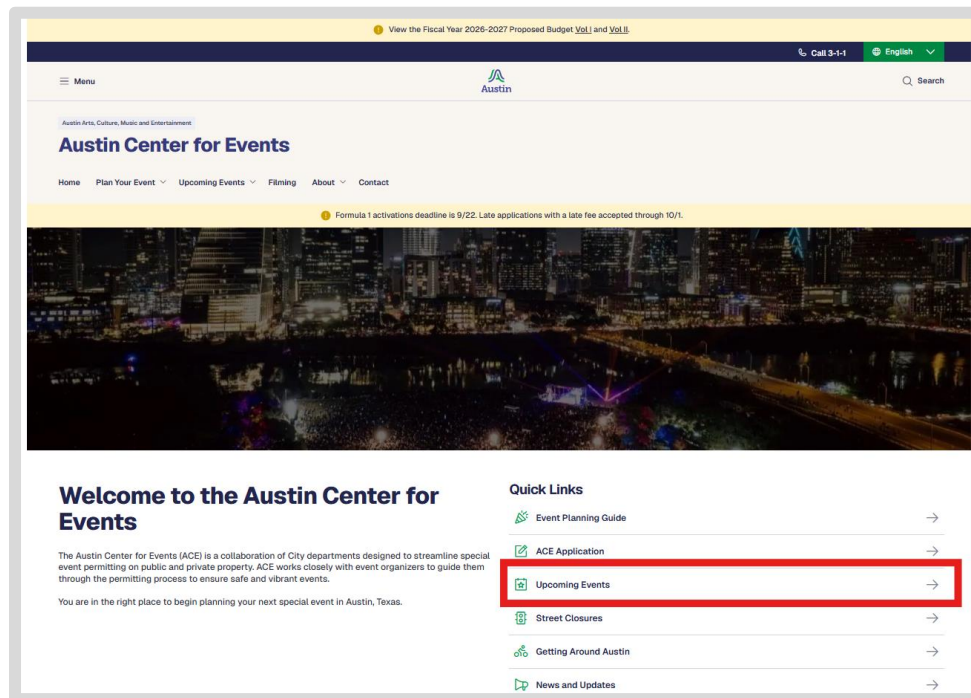

Zilker Park & Barton Springs Pool Details	Parking Lot Closure Information • Pecan Grove Lot Closes 9/18 • Great Lawn Closes 9/21 • Rock Garden Lot 9/23 • Moontower Lot, Disc Golf Lot, Playscape Lot Close 9/28 Barton Springs Pool • Open AT ALL TIMES during normal hours. • http://www.austintexas.gov/departments/barton-springs-pool • Pool Access Map OPEN AREAS – pre-event days, and in between event weekends • Zilker Park – Picnic Areas, Playscape (South of Barton Springs Road), Barton Springs Pool • Rugby Field greenspace until 10/1 • Facilities – Nature Center, Botanical Gardens, Splash Exhibit • In addition, Auditorium Shores and Butler Park will be open.
Neighborhood Parking Restrictions and Parking Enforcement	Parking Restriction Signage • Restricted “NO PARKING” signage will be installed in Zilker, Bouldin, Barton Hills and Deep Eddy neighborhoods. • Signage will be installed prior to event days to allow time required for installation, and review/corrections. • Signage will stay posted between event weekends. • City of Rollingwood has no parking zones in effect as well. See City of Rollingwood website. • TIP! - If you need additional parking – park your OWN vehicle in LEGAL on street parking and save a driveway for guests.

	Parking Enforcement • Temporary signed neighborhood “no parking areas” are actively enforced only on event days (Friday, Saturday, and Sunday). • Call or use the 311 mobile app to report parking violations.
General Violations	Examples of what to call in: • Parking within 30’ of the approach to a stop sign. • Parking or blocking within <u>15’ of a fire hydrant</u>. • Parking left wheel to curb. (cars parked facing against traffic). • If a car blocks <u>YOUR</u> driveway. Some neighbors may permit people to block their OWN driveway. • <i>REMINDER: Make a quick note of the vehicle’s color, make, and model before you call!</i> • Illegal vending/sales questions in the immediate festival area.
Dockless Devices	Dockless Device drop off at: • Toomey Rd in the Butler Shores/Baseball Field parking lot • Lee Barton Dr near Starbucks • Azie Morton Rd near Wright Field across from Umlauf • Veterans Drive just east of Mopac near the MetroBike Station Dockless devices Reporting: use the Austin 311 app <u>using the ‘shared micromobility’ option</u> - The 311 App is most helpful for this purpose as it allows you to geolocate the position of the complaint and attach an image.
Shuttles	<u>Free</u> festival shuttles run from downtown at Sand Beach Park to the site! NOTE: There is minimal public parking near the Park, suggest alternative transportation.
ADA	<u>ADA and Accessibility Accommodations</u> are within the event’s “Access Center” Access Center is located in between the East and West Entry gates with services: • Answers to questions specific to the accessibility program • Information relevant to our patrons with disabilities • Requests for accessibility Wristbands • Power outlets for recharging powered mobility devices • Programming information in large print and braille for reference • Assisted Listening Devices (ALDs) • Chilled medical storage (cooler only) Signage will be placed at the Festival identifying all <i>accessible viewing areas for patrons with mobility needs</i> and patrons who are Deaf/Hard of Hearing. Transportation Options: Shuttles are ADA compliant, CapMetro Access program, ADA Parking (first come first serve while available, and Drop Off/Pick Up

Low Flying Aircraft

FAA low flying aircraft information. The San Antonio Flight Standards District Office (FSDO) is the office that would take complaints about safety violations. That number is (800) 292-2023.

The FAA does not, however, take calls regarding nuisance complaints.

Nuisance/aircraft noise complaints would go to the Aviation Department. Number is (512) 530-5541.



- 311 app is the proper tool for dockless device reporting (scooters, dockless bikes, or similar).
- Submit 311 requests for dockless devices that are blocking, impeding or causing safety issues in the City. This will allow the city to have a documented record of issues regarding operations. 311 has a very helpful app to aid in reporting.

Prepare to use the FREE app:

- Download the Austin 311 app to your smartphone (see links below) – or go to your phone's app store.
- You can choose to put in your information and email to receive a copy of the report.

Using the app:

1. Open the app
2. Select “**new request**” in the top left
3. Scroll to the bottom – **choose “other”**
4. **Select “request for service”**
5. Using the photo feature, take a clear image of the device from enough distance that shows the issue, and identifies the device. *Not too close, not too far away!*
6. Hit location and use the phones GPS feature to report the location. The GPS icon in the top right will identify your current location.
7. You can type a few notes if warranted and then hit submit.
